We have had another short but exciting month together in English class.

December Theme: WINTER WONDERLAND

Objectives:

Worksheets

Stories

We continue to read different story books. This month the children loved the story about Mog the cat who was very sad because no one had time for him. Everyone was busy preparing for Christmas.
