

English Revision for Exam 1

Dear Students,

English Exam 1 will take place on the 26th and 27th of November 2020. The exam will be based on the units that we have studied in the <u>Global English 1</u> books, the exercises in the plastic folder, orange notebook and the homework assignments that you've done. The page numbers below are from the <u>Global English 1</u> student book. However, there are excellent exercises in the activity book as well. **All questions** will be similar to what we have done in class. It is nothing to be worried about.

- 1. **Grammar**: exercises in <u>Global English</u> and the orange notebook
 - Regular Plurals: adding an "s" at the end of a noun (example: book, books)
 - Pronouns: I, you, he/she/it, we, you, they and his/her (example: page 17 <u>Global English + orange notebook)</u>
 - Articles: a or an (orange notebook)
 - Magic "e": can/cane, man/mane, tap/tape, tub/tube, cut/cute, cap/cape (orange notebook/plastic folder)
 - -ay and -ai words: day, way, say, stay, pay, bay; snail, sail, train, paint (orange notebook/plastic folder)
 - Sentence Punctuation: A sentence starts with a capital and ends with a full-stop / period, a question mark or an exclamation mark. Names of people and places (cities, countries) start with a capital letter.
 - Verbs in the present tense: go, see, play, kick, eat, like, play, write, read, jump, run, be
 - in the negative form: do/don't (page 25 Global English 1 + orange notebook)
 - Rhyming Words: hat/cat/sat/mat/pat, man/can, log/frog etc (<u>orange notebook/plastic folder</u>)
- 2. Vocabulary: exercises in Global English the orange notebook, plastic folder and spelling homework
 - Days of the week.
 - The months: September, October, November, December
 - Numbers in words: one to twenty; Numbers in numerals: 1-100
 - Colours: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, pink, white, brown, black, gold, silver (page 9 Global English 1)
 - Family members: grandfather/grandpa, grandmother/grandma, father, mother, brother, sister, baby, uncle, aunt, cousin (page 25 <u>Global English 1</u>, orange notebook)
 - Animals: bird, duck, chick, rabbit, squirrel, mouse, fish, horse, elephant (page 18-21 Global English 1)
 - Fruits: apple banana etc (page 27 <u>Global English 1</u>, orange notebook, plastic folder)
 - Foods: bread, rice, yogurt, soup, milk, eggs (page 26 <u>Global English 1</u> and orange notebook)

Review the phrases learned for our spelling tests, these include nearly all of the above words.

3. Reading and Listening Comprehension

- Reading comprehension: you will read a short text and answer different questions.
 (example: page 12/18-20/26 in <u>Global English 1</u>)
- Listening comprehension: you will listen to a short text and answer different questions.

4. Writing

- Remember correct sentence structure capital letters and punctuation
- Answering questions in full sentences.
- Writing words in the correct order to make a sentence.

You have all been working hard in class. I know you will do well if you work carefully. If you have any questions, please ask! Remember the more you revise the easier the exam will be! Try to study 10-15 minutes every day!
