English Revision for Exam 1

Dear Students,

English Exam 1 will take place on the 26th and 27th of November 2020. The exam will be based on Units 1-6 in **Oxford Discover 5** and the notes, exercises in the **orange notebooks, worksheets in plastic folders** and **homework assignments**. Questions will be similar to those we have worked on in class.

1. Vocabulary

- Words with different suffixes and prefixes: orange notebook, plastic folder and homework
- Words from our spelling homework
- Matching: words and definitions

2. Grammar

- Verb Tenses: present, present perfect, present continuous, past, past perfect, future
- Verbs + Infinitives: example – We **decided to watch** a movie on Friday.
- Irregular Verbs: for example be, go, eat, see etc
- Interjections!
- Adjectives + Preposition: at, about, of, to
- Special Adjectives: comparative / superlative
- Sentence structure: analyse a sentence and indicate different parts of speech. (noun, pronoun, verb, adverb, adjective, article, preposition)
- Modal (helping) Verbs: i) modals of ability ii) modals of certainty
- Nouns: common, proper, abstract
- synonyms antonyms homonyms

3. Reading and Listening Comprehension

- Reading comprehension: you will read a text and answer different questions.
- Listening comprehension: you will listen to a text and answer different questions.
- Matching sentence parts; adding the correct word to a sentence, joining two sentences.

4. Writing

- Short composition: introduction, body, conclusion
- Using correct punctuation, capitalization and spelling

We will revise for the test during class. However, it is your responsibility to study on your own. If you have any questions, please ask! Try and study at least 15 minutes a day! If you review a little every day, I'm sure you'll do well. Most of you have worked **attentively** in class. I really enjoy coming to school every day to teach you. Keep up the excellent work!
